Dear Parents/Guardians,

SVRCS is taking the appropriate measures to ensure the health and safety of your children as we return to school.

- All students will receive a SVRCS mask to wear at designated times throughout the day. These masks are theirs to keep. Please sanitize masks each evening. It is fine if your child prefers a different mask that you have provided. Face shields are also available upon request.
- Upon arrival the students will enter the multi-purpose room and have their temperature checked before receiving the grab and go breakfast. If a student has a temperature of 100.4 or more, the student will be referred to the nurse for further evaluation. Your child is not required to take breakfast. At this time, children will proceed to homerooms to prepare for the day and eat breakfast.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in every classroom and all offices.
- The water fountains will now be water bottle filling stations. I would recommend that each student bring 12 oz. water bottle each day and take it home to be sanitized each day.
- The K-6 grade desks will be separated and a clear plastic shield will be placed on each one. These grades will also have staggered lunch periods where lunch tables will also be equipped with protective shields.
- Grades K-8 Specialty classes will be offered in their homerooms to minimize travel throughout the school buildings.
- All students will be issued a scan card that is attached to their lunch account. K-6 graders will keep their cards in their homerooms. 7-12 will be able to carry their cards with them.
- Portable personal shields will be carried by grades 7-12 to help ensure safety. These clear plastic shields must be used anytime a student is seated to provide a physical barrier between students. They will be eating lunch in their homerooms.
- Be assured that cleaning will take place consistently and the buildings will be disinfected each evening.
